The QES PTA is a registered 501c3, that advocates for the students and families within the Quarterfield community.



- Block Party was a huge success!
 - We budgeted \$2,500 for the event
 - \$2048.30 spent
 - \$225.00 revenue
 - \$1823.31 net cost (\$679.69 under budget)

Treasurer's Report

- 2023-2024 Financial Review
 - We passed! With some notes:
 - Need to include check copies with disbursement forms
 - One disbursement form was missing the associated receipt
 - All cash verification reports need to be signed by 2 people
 - Need to attach deposit slips to cash verification forms
 - Final budget needs to be in the binder to show year end totals
- 2024-2025 Budget Review
- July and August Bank Reconciliation
- Proposed Budget Amendment

Proposed Budget Amendment

- Transfer excess funds from Special Events -> Block Party
 - \$75 to a new budget line Student Support -> Career Day
 - Previous value \$0, to \$75
 - Funds to be used by Ms. Dennison in support of costs to put on Career Day.
 - \$75 to Operating Expenses -> Supplies
 - Previous value \$350, to \$425
 - Funds to be used to purchase Giveback POS machine, so we can accept card payments at events
 - \$525 to Staff Support -> Staff Revitalization
 - Previous value \$1,200, to \$1,725
 - Funds to be used towards purchase of new Die Cut Machine

Treasurer Vacancy


- The vacancy was announced via email and Facebook on Sunday, September 15th.
